Temporary road closures April - June 2019

Somerset County Council has informed us that their contractor Skanska will be carrying out drainage improvement work in the village from April to June this year. This will result in the following temporary road closures:

8th April to 3rd May (4 weeks)
B3188 North End
upgrade pipe and improve road gullies

7th May to 24th May (3 weeks)
Beech Tree Hill
upgrade pipe and improve road gullies

3rd June to 7th June (1 week)
B3188 Front Street
upgrade pipe crossing the road to the river

10th June to 28th June (3 weeks)
High Street
upgrade pipe, build new road gully and add new grille to upstream entrance to the pipe

These works are designed to help prevent surface water flooding in the village, and have been funded by a special grant from the Somerset Rivers Authority.
